Nathan Taylor Education Fund

The Nathan Taylor Education Fund operates to give financial support to those who have experienced the care system or are Care Leavers aged 18yrs up to 25yrs. Funds are considered to support access the labour market and or go into self-employment (aged up to 29yrs).

Grants can cover a range of items including part cost or full cost of education/training programs, specialist work clothes, items needed for the work place and items needed for a business e.g. insurance, business cards etc.

All applications will be considered by a committee comprising business leaders, members of the community, officers of the council and young people. It is expected that you will have exhausted all avenues of support via your support worker and the local authority and that entitlements afforded to you under relevant Acts and Guidance have been considered. There is a section in the form for your support worker to highlight this.
